Dear Ducati Club Racer,

Thank you for participating to the Ducati Club Race 2025. Please read this letter carefully so that you know what happened and expected from you.

Arrival and registration

The paddock is opened for us from Thursday 22 May 2:00 p.m. There will be a track day from another organization on Thursday so please respect their place at the paddock. From 7:00 p.m. the paddock will be completely ours. To access the paddock, please report to Welcome Centre (at the gate). You can bring 2 mechanics per participant.

After you've arrived, you report in person at the Media Centre (above the pitboxes) for collecting your rider's/ passenger documents. On Thursday, registration at the Media Centre opens at 3:00 p.m. If you have a racing license, take it with you. We need to check it for the day license. You can find the opening hours for the Welcome Centre, the Media Centre, transponder registration and technical inspection in the Supplementary regulations on the website.

Technical inspection:

In addition to the technical inspection of your motorcycle (WITHOUT fairing), you must also present your motorcycle clothing and helmet for inspection. This does not have to happen simultaneously. However, both are required to be inspected before entering the circuit. This also applies to the training sessions on Friday. After your motorcycle and your clothing are inspected, you will receive a half sticker placed on the helmet and a briefing card. Racing classes that run under the FIM/KNMV license can report to the inspection from Thursday 6:30 p.m. This applies to the NK Classics in the TC building. The sidecars are inspected on the paddock.

Briefing:

The <u>mandatory</u> driver briefing will take place in the Media Center on Friday evening at 8:15 p.m. After the briefing, upon presentation of the briefing ticket, you will receive the second half of the helmet sticker that gives access to the circuit on Saturday and Sunday. The driver briefing is mandatory for everyone, so make sure you don't miss this briefing!

Other things:

If you share your bike with another rider, you both need to have an own transponder. Don't forget changing the transponder and number with the rider!

Access to the track the entire weekend (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) is through parc fermée at the end of the paddock and not through the pitlane. Except for the Camathias Cup and the Northern Sidecar Cup.

Make sure you've collected your rider's documents at the Media Centre in time. Your right to participate expires when you haven't collected your rider's documentation on time.

- > If you only ride the race on Saturday and Sunday: ultimately Saturday 9:00 a.m.
