Special Regulations

Art. 1 – Definition

ASBL Circuit de Chimay is organizing on 26th and 27th July 2025, the 15th edition of the Open Trophy of Chimay. This is a Europe Open event.

This event is counting for the BeNeLux Trophy, the Belgian Championship Road Race, International Road Race Championship (IRRC) and Northern Sidecar Cup. The contest is bound to the regulations of the «Fédération Motocyclisme de Belgique» (F.M.B.), these Special Regulations and their respective annexes.

By his registration, the pilot must submit himself to all these regulations.

Art. 2 - Circuit

Circuit of Chimay, length: 4.420km. Events are competed in the clockwise direction. Every maneuver indicating a wrong use of the prescribed direction will immediately be excluded from the contest.

Art. 3 – Participants: Registrations and maximum number

Races are open to the owners of a National, European or International Road Racing license valid according to their category. The access to points for the championship of Belgium is governed by the sports regulation FMB 2025.

The holders of a foreign permit must be in possession of a starting permit from their National Federation!!! No starting permission = no participation!!!

Motorcycles must be conforming to the technical requirements present in the 2025 regulation "Road Race" of the FMB as regards the categories officially resumed in the Belgian championship.

The maximum number of motorcycles on track is:

- 38 motorcycles in race 45 motorcycles during training.
- 22 sidecars in race 26 side-cars during training.

Riders' equipment must apply to the specifications found in 2025 race regulation FMB.

Art. 4 – Race number

The race numbers will be communicated one week before the event to the foreign runners

by the acceptance of their commitment. FMB licensed riders participate in the event in all sprint events with the start number listed on their 2025 license for the same sprint class. The confirmation of commitment to the event will be notified in writing or by email following the data in possession of the organizer and according to the date of registration.

Art. 5 – Admitted categories

Art. 6 - Subscription

The subscription fee gives right to access bracelets (rider and guest) and is:

The participants of the classes: **Sidecars, Belgian Twin Trophy** & **IRRC** categories must be included on the list of the competitors in this category and the payment must be done to the promoter of each category.

The entry form has to be completed on the website https://fmbrace.ristiming.be/raceVIT.php?langue=GB, one week before the event, on the 15th July 2025 at the latest. After this date, online registrations won't be possible anymore! Subscriptions and payments will be made at the welcome desk (in the limit of places available in each category).

For payment on site: the rate will be increased by 20€ even if the registration was made online on time.

ATTENTION: Registration will only be approved when the correct entry fee has been received.

Payment must be made at the time of ordering by one of the following methods. The registration fee does not include bank charges. These will be added at the time of registration. Once the registration is done, you will receive a confirmation email.

Pilots must have their proof of payment (copy of bank statement). This is very important, especially for pilots who have paid at the last minute.

In case of cancellation of the entry of the rider <u>before the 15^{th of} July 2025</u>, the organizer will refund 50% of the participation fee. After the 15^{th of} July 2025, the rider will not be refunded. Any registration that must be cancelled due to serious illness or death of the participant will be refund at 95% upon presentation of a medical certificate.

Art. 7 – Access to paddocks

The paddock area will be accessible from Thursday 24th of July 2025, from 9:00 am. It is forbidden to mark out a site in advance, except for special structures or groups of drivers who have received prior agreement from the organizer at info@circuit.be before Monday 14th of July 2025. The organizer reserves the right to remove any unauthorized markings.

Compared with previous years, some of the paddocks have become inaccessible. A team of stewards will allocate you a pitch of +/- 50m2 on arrival (see addendum with map).

Only the riders in possession of valid access documents will have access to the runner's park. The access documents must be removed at the "Welcome pilots" located at the "Marché d'Antan" – Rue de l'Eau Blanche 6461, Virelles (Chimay) - GPS: 50.062846, 4.334715. The Guest bracelets will also be given there (no ticket will be sent to the pilot). The pilot is responsible for distributing them to his guests before entering the paddocks. If a guest has not received his bracelet and decides to pay at the entrance, it will NOT be refunded after that.

The guests who bought a presale can present themselves directly at the entrance where

their E-tickets will be exchanged for a bracelet.

(Please note, tickets contain unique barcodes, when scanned, they are no longer valid. Reproduction of these is useless.)

If the pilot didn't pay before the event (15th of July 2025): formalities, payment and access authorization must be done at the "welcome pilots" as indicated above!

Every settlement of trading activity or private catering must be subject by a written request to the host at least three weeks before the event.

Any circulation of children on minibikes is **strictly forbidden** in the paddocks.

Pilots are responsible for the actions of their mechanics, team personnel and their guests.

Art.7B – Use of the organizer's electrical network

The electricity network of the organizer can only supplement the necessities of the organization, and an additional comfort measured (limited to 6A) to the participants occasionally residing in the paddocks.

It is therefore prohibited on this network to:

- Heat up tires
- Charge batteries of any electric or hybrid powered vehicle

Art. 8 – "Welcome Pilots": Administrative Verification

The "Welcome Pilots" is installed on the outside of the site, in Virelles (Rue de l'Eau Blanche, 6461 Virelles).

It will be accessible as follows:

- Thursday 24th of July 2025: from 9:00 am to 10:30 pm
- Friday 25th of July 2025: from 8:30 am to 10:30 pm

Saturday morning: permanence at the race directions office in the pitlane

After check, organizers will give:

- Form for technical inspection
- «Pilot» and «Track Access» bracelets
- Confirmation of the race number

Each rider will also receive a weekend program, a rubbish bag and two car passes.

The "pilot" wristbands give you access to toilets and showers for free.

The wristbands «pilot» and «Track Access» grant <u>only</u> access to the pitlane and the «parcfermé». It is valid **only** if shown with the weekend bracelet!

Access to the «parc-fermé» will be refused to the riders without the specific wristband.

Art. 9 - Technical Inspection

Technical Inspection is compulsory for the motorcycle and for the equipment of the rider. It is in the small tent next to the "parc fermé".

Every motorcycle must be submitted to the technical inspection at least one hour before the time scheduled on their category for first training.

A sound emission check on every machine is SYSTEMATICALLY scheduled.

(cfr FMB 2025's «Road Race» technical regulations)

It will be accessible as follows:

Friday 25th of July 2025: from 6:00 pm till 9:00 pm

Saturday 26th of July 2025: from 8:00 am
 Sunday 27th of July 2025: from 8:00 am

Art. 10 - Briefing

The pilots' briefing is mandatory and will take place on Friday 25th of July at 8 pm in the tent.

Art. 11 – Progress of the event

The progress of the championship races of Belgium is governed by the sports code FMB-BMB.

<u>ATTENTION:</u> At the start of the 1st training session, an official car will be riding in front of the riders during 2 rounds. The riders will be riding in one line behind the official car! Overtaking is **strictly forbidden** during these laps.

Unsafe behavior or to not follow this procedure can result in a penalty or up to the definitive exclusion of the offender without refund.

At the end of each round, or practice, the pilots will return to the paddock via the pitlane by finishing their tour, in a normal speed without stopping on the track.

Art. 12 – Demo Open 2T

The demo Open 2T is not a race; there is no spirit of competition at all. Any behaviour not corresponding to this state of mind will be punished by the exclusion of the event.

All racing motorbikes with a 2-stroke engine between 124 and 500cc, dating from at least 1982, are eligible. Bikes have to comply with the technical safety requirements set out in the FMB's general technical regulations "road racing".

Riders' equipment must meet the minimum safety requirements set out in the FMB's road racing regulations.

Only machines, which the technical file would have been accepted before, will be admitted by the Organizer. This file must contain the following data about the bike:

- 2 pictures
- Complete information about the bike
- A description
- A record list of the bike if possible

Attention:

- The technical inspection (for the bike and the racer equipment) is also obligatory for this category
- The departure of the Demo Open 2T only will be given from the "parc fermé"

<u>Art. 13 – Environmental concepts</u>

Each rider has to have an **«environmental carpet»** conform to the legislation law, it has to be placed under the machine permanently.

Carpets will be available at the "welcome pilots" for 25€.

Each rider will receive a trash bag that has to be closed and dropped in one of the metal containers in the paddock.

Each participant is responsible and is requested to take back its used oil, used tyres and other hydrocarbon waste to eliminate them by their own care. (There is no special drain oil container available on the site).

All overrules concerning this will be severely punished (exclusion of the meeting).

Art. 14 – Speed limit

Speed limit is scheduled at maximum:

- In the pitlane: 60km/h
- In the paddock: 20km/h

It is strictly forbidden for children below 16 years old to ride a motorcycle at the paddock. A helmet is compulsory, according to the law.

Art 15 – Rules modifications

The organizer, in agreement with the Race Director, reserves the right to make any changes to these regulations that he deems necessary for the smooth running of the race. The riders will be informed by a notice from the race direction. The modifications will be available at the race director office.

Art. 16 - Claims

Every complaint must be in written and handed over to the Race Director in accordance with the rules determined by the Belgian Regulations «Road Race» and Classic Bikes for the season 2025.

Art. 17 - Prices

There is no price money scheduled.
