

1st MOTORRACE EVENT CAROLE (France) 30th & 31st APRIL 2025 SPECIAL REGULATIONS IMN 191 / 61 EMN 10 / 1913





1. On Saturday 30th and Sunday 31st of August 2025, the "K.V. Ostend Motor Sport association" is organizing a Motorrace Contest in Carole, France. Training a contest will take place according to the schedule in annex. The organizing clud is MC Motor Events and the promotor is K.V. Ostend Motor Sport.

Next classes are allowed: Superbike, Supersport, WBB Supersport & Superbike, Belgian Supersport, Supersport 2000 & Superbike Youngtimer, Belgian Supertwin & Stocktwin 650, Northern Sidecar Cup 600 & 1000, Yamaha Cup R3 & R7 and Freetech 50/Classic 50 Eurocup.

The contests are considered for the BeNeLux Trophy, the Belgian Championship Road Racing, the Duth Championship Road Racing, Northern sidecar Cup, Yamaha Cup R3 & R7 and Freetech 50/Classic 50 Eurocup.

The contest is bound to the regulations of the "Fédération Internationale Motocycliste" (FIM), the "Belgische Motorrijders Bond" (B.M.B.) and these Special Regulations. By his registration, the pilot must submit himself to all these regulations.

- 2. The circuit has a length of 2.055 meters. The contests will be run counterclockwise. Every manoeuvre indicating a wrong use of the prescribed direction will immediately be excluded from the contest.
- 3. <u>Info</u>: On Friday 29th of August 2025 there will be a "Trackday". You can subscribe at <u>www.ostendmotorsport.be</u>. (Attention: the places are limited !!)
- 4. Timing 30th & 31st of August 2025: see attachment.
- 5. Starting procedure for all classes on 30th & 31st of August 2025 is mentioned in the B.M.B. Regulations "Snelheid 2025".

The allowed amount bikes during the the contests will be 30 (Solos) and 20 (Sidecars). The allowed amount bikes during the training periods will be 36 (Solos) and 24 (Sidecars).

- 6. The 3 (three) best racers from every heat will be honoured. The honouring will start after each heat. Please respect the timing.
- 7. There is no price money scheduled.
- 8. <u>Complaints</u>: every complaint must be in written and handed over to the Race Director in accordance with the rules determined by the "Disciplinaire Code B.M.B.".
- 9. The manifestation is administered in accordance with the national sport code and these Special Regulations. The pilots must know the rules.
- 10. Startprocedure on 31st of August 2025 starts at the sign "30 seconds"!!! Nobody will be allowed at the startgrid after the reconnaissance round!!!
- 11. At the end of each contest, the riders will ride a complete round and enter the paddock.
- 12. The machines of the riders must be equipped according to requirements of the B.M.B. The drivers must wear a helmet and equipped in leather and this during the training sessions and during the races.
- 13. The Technical Control for the events of the weekend will take place on Friday 29th of August 2025 starting at 18 hr till 21 hr and on Saturday 30th of August 2025 starting at 07.15 hr. The Technical Control will find place at the technical boxes in the pit lane.

All pilots and passengers must present their motorcycle and their full equipment (helmet, leather suit, leather gloves, boots)!

14. On arrival at Carole and before being admitted to the paddock, a check is provided for the pilots and accompanying persons. The entrance is not free. Each pilot gets free access for himself and 3 accompanying persons. For the sidecar teams, the pilot and passenger get free access + 3 accompanying persons. Extra entry tickets can be purchased on place.

A maximum of 2 vehicles per pilot are allowed on the paddock. Additional vehicles must park in the visitor's parking.

15. After arrival in the paddock, participants must present themselves at the "INFO" in order to receive all necessary documents which will allow access to the event.

The "Info" will be opened on Friday 29th of August 2025 from 18.00hr till 21.30hr and on Saturday 30th of April 2025 from 07.00hr.

- 16. Only with a correct bracelet you'll get access to the pit lane. Dogs and children under 16 are not allowed in the pit lane.
- 17. Any movement by children on mini motors in the paddock is strictly forbidden. The maximum speed in the paddock is 10 km/h. Wearing a helmet is mandatory.
- 18. Pilots are responsible for the actions of their mechanics, team personnel and their guests.
- 19. Dogs are allowed in the paddock but must always be on a leash. Owners are always responsible for their dog.
- 20. Pilots & teams must deposit all their waste in the appropriate waste containers. These are available next to the bar.
- 21. Barbecues are forbidden in the paddock for safety reasons.
- 22. It is forbidden to offer food or drinks (free or paying). Teams can only offer catering to their own team members.
- 23. It is **forbidden** to leave used tyres on the site.
- 24. The parents are reminded that they are responsible for their children on and around the paddock. The organization can't be held responsible in case of injury or accident.

27. Licenses

For the event, the pilot must be the owner of a license issued by a motor federation which is recognized by the UEM or FIM. Foreign participants need a starting allowance issued by their own federation.

The pilots who don't have a license for the classes <u>Freetech 50/Classic 50 Eurocup</u> must acquire a "license 1 manifestation". A "license 1 manifestation" can be obtained at the "INFO" and the cost is $75 \in$.

30. Transponder

The use of a transponder is mandatory for the contest. Your transponder must be fully charged and in perfect condition. The number of your transponder must be communicated upon arrival at the "INFO". It is also possible to rent a transponder.

The fee for the rent is $30 \in$.

The driver's permit or identity card must be provided as a guarantee!!!

- 31. The paddock is accessible from Thursday 28th August 2025 at 6.30 pm. Everyone must have left Paddock 1 on Sunday 31st August 2025 at 12.00 pm. If you want to leave the circuit later, you have to place yourself on Paddock 0, 1bis or 2.
- 32. The participant must subscribe with the "Entry Form" <u>before 15th of August 2025</u>. Every subscription that is later then 15th of August 2025 can be refused if the classes are complete.
- 33. A pilot who has registered can cancel his registration. If he does before 15th of August 2025, he will receive 100% of his registration amount. As of 15th of August 2025, no refund of the registration amount will be made.
